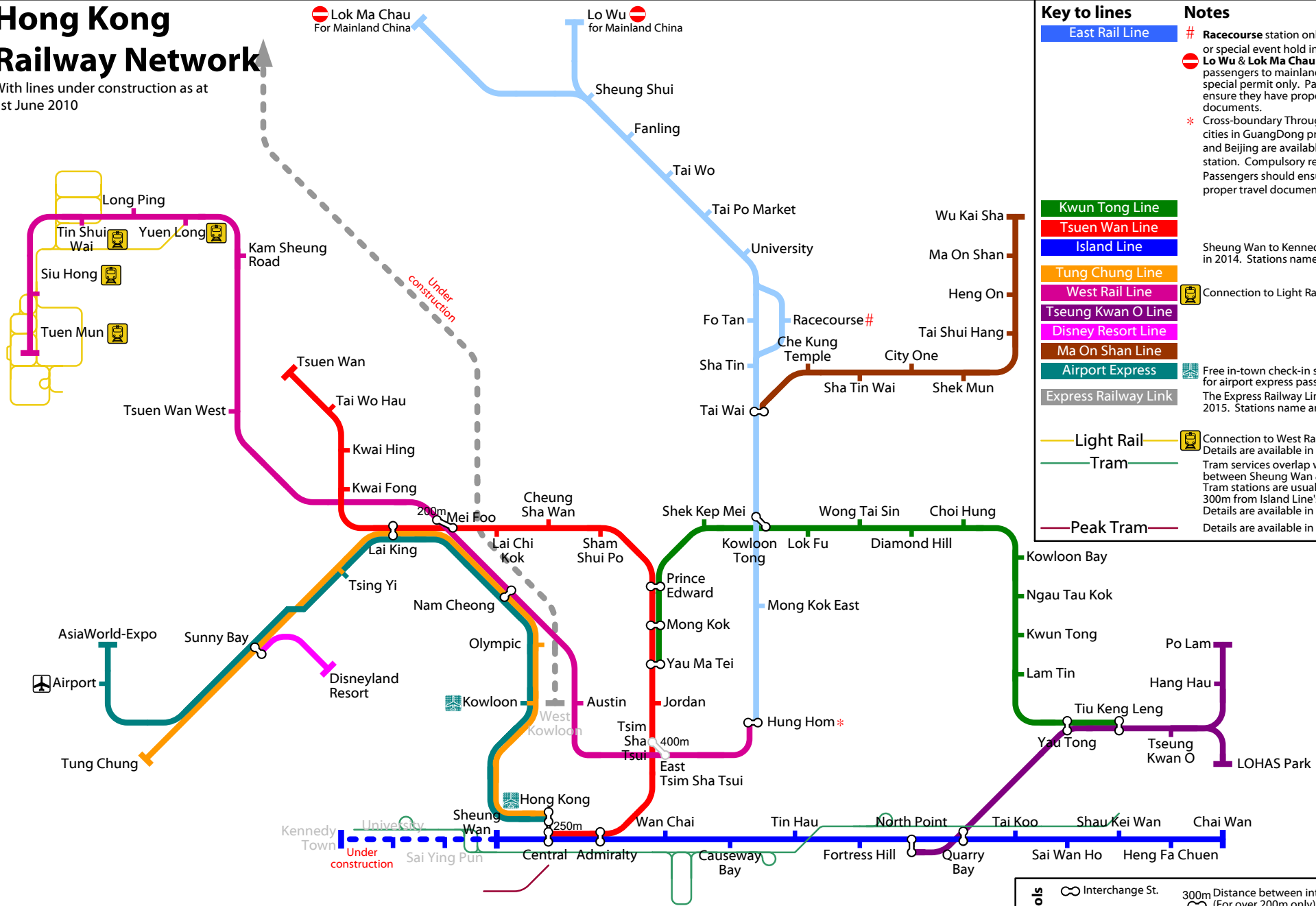


# Hong Kong Railway Network

Key to lines	Notes
<b>East Rail Line</b>	# Racecourse station only open when race or special event hold in Shatin Racecourse.
<b>Kwun Tong Line</b>	Lo Wu & Lok Ma Chau stations for passengers to mainland China or with special permit only. Passengers should ensure they have proper travel documents.
<b>Tsuen Wan Line</b>	* Cross-boundary Through Train services to cities in GuangDong province, Shanghai and Beijing are available in <b>Hung Hom</b> station. Compulsory reservation. Passengers should ensure they have proper travel documents.
<b>Island Line</b>	Sheung Wan to Kennedy Town will open in 2014. Stations name are tentative.
<b>Tung Chung Line</b>	Connection to Light Rail.
<b>West Rail Line</b>	Free in-town check-in services available for airport express passengers
<b>Tseung Kwan O Line</b>	The Express Railway Link will open in 2015. Stations name are tentative.
